

Directions to 1854 Erin Drive, Altoona (Greenwood Section)

From Altoona:

Drive Pleasant Valley Blvd toward Bellwood. In Bellmead, turn Right on Bellmead Drive at Sheetz. Drive 1 mile on Bellmead Drive, the road will dip down. Turn Right on Erin Drive. Road will turn left as it goes uphill. House is 2nd on left after the left turn. House is blue with white trim.

From Tyrone area:

If on I-99, exit at 139 (Pinecroft). At foot of ramp, turn right. At traffic light on Pleasant Valley Blvd, turn left. At traffic light at Martin's Supermarket, turn left. In about 500 feet, turn right on Bellmead Drive. Go 1 mile and road goes into a dip. Turn left on Erin Drive. Road will turn left as it goes uphill. House is 2nd on left after the left turn. House is blue with white trim.
